

Ailey's 2009 New York Season to Honor Jamison

How do you pay tribute to **Judith Jamison**? With a lot of dancing, of course. Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater is celebrating Ms. Ja-



mison's 20th year as artistic director with a five-week season in her honor, running from Dec. 2 through Jan. 3 at City Center. A few of the highlights of the engagement include a world premiere by Ronald K. Brown about Ms. Jamison, left; an appearance by the actress Anna Deavere Smith; a new work inspired by the Harlem Renaissance by a company veteran, Matthew Rushing; and a new ballet by Ms. Jamison set to original jazz compositions by Eric Lewis. The company will also present the premiere of Robert Battle's "In/Side," with music by Nina Simone, and a "Best of 20 Years" program featuring many of the nearly 100 ballets that Ms. Jamison commissioned or revived

during her tenure. The opening night gala will be hosted by **Pauletta Washington** and **Denzel Washington**. Ms. Jamison announced last year that she would retire in 2011.
